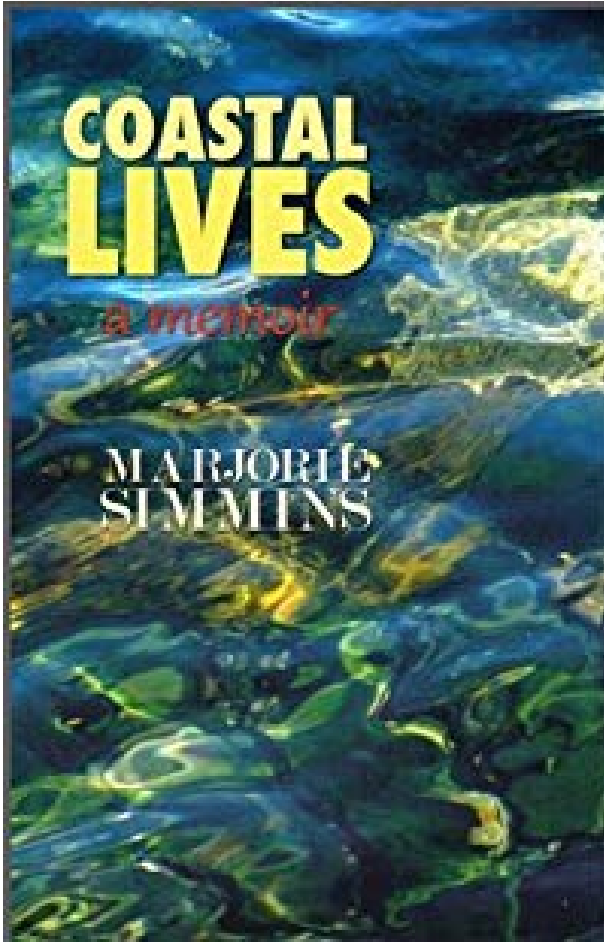


# Coastal Lives: A Memoir
