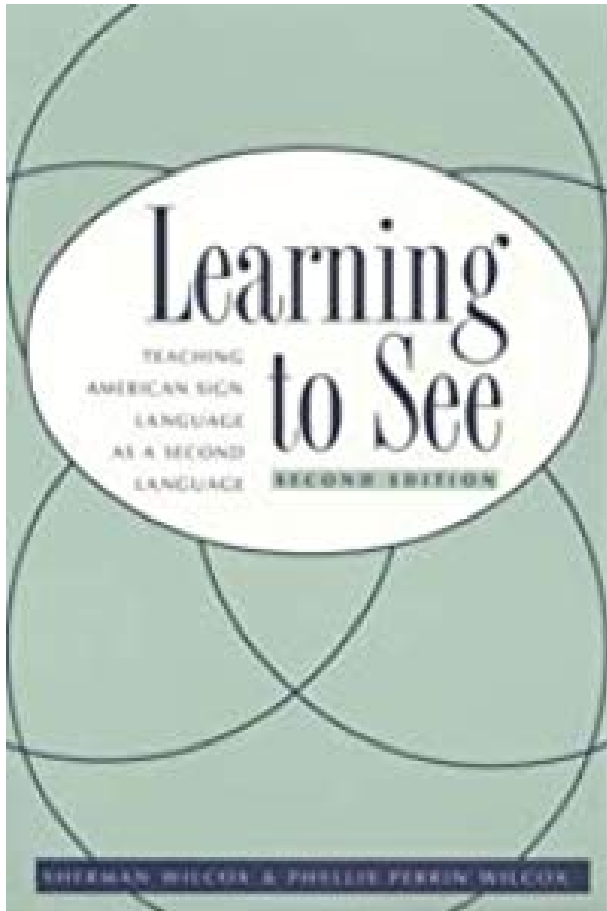


# Learning to See: Teaching American Sign Language as a Second Language
