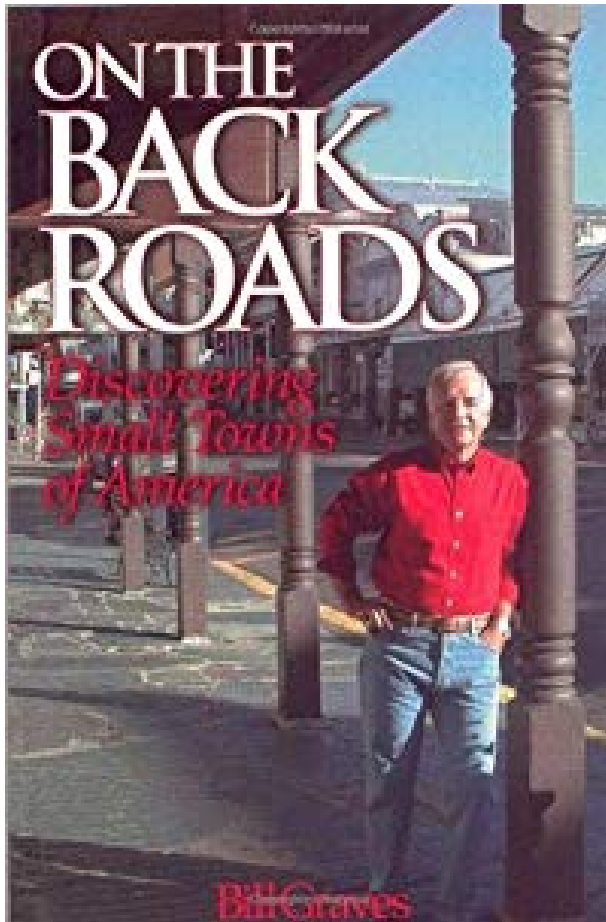


# On the Back Roads: Discovering Small Towns of America
